## AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to educational programs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 167.271, to read as follows:

- 167.271. 1. Any school district may create a committee to work with teachers and organized parental groups to provide youth-at-risk after school and summer art, science and math programs to minors at least five years of age and not more than fourteen years of age.
- 2. Curricula criteria may be developed by accredited teachers, parental groups and the committee.
  - 3. The committee may accept funds from any source for the programs.
