AN ACT

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to business video surveillance of firearms and ammunition, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 407.495, to read as follows:

**407.495. 1. Any business selling firearms or ammunition shall use
2 video surveillance cameras to continuously record the area where such
3 firearms or ammunition are displayed or sold, so that the products,
4 customers, and employees are taped at all times. The tape from such
5 surveillance cameras shall be properly stored by the business for not
6 less than thirty days from the date it was recorded and shall be made
7 available to law enforcement upon request.**

8 **2. Any business violating this section shall be fined five hundred
9 dollars for each day of such violation.**
