AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to assessment of certain penalties on intoxication-related traffic offenses, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 577.640, to read as follows:

577.640. 1. Whenever a person has pleaded guilty to or has been
2 found guilty of a first-time intoxication-related traffic offense, an
3 additional penalty of one thousand dollars shall be assessed. In all
4 second or subsequent intoxication-related traffic offense cases, an
5 additional penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars shall be
6 assessed. The penalties authorized by this section shall be in addition
7 to any other penalty authorized by law. All moneys recovered from the
8 penalties imposed by this section shall be credited to the public school
9 fund as provided by law for other fines and penalties.

10 2. As used in this section, the term "intoxication-related traffic
11 offense" shall have the same meaning ascribed to it in section 577.023.
