AN ACT

To repeal section 294.027, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to work certificates that permit minors to work.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 294.027, RSMo, is repealed and one new section
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 294.027, to read as follows:

294.027. Work certificates shall permit

2 (1) The employment of children [between] fourteen [and sixteen] **or**
3 **fifteen** years of age during nonschool hours during the school term; or

4 (2) The employment of children [between] fourteen [and sixteen] **or**
5 **fifteen** years of age who are excused from attendance at school by the provisions
6 of chapter 167.
