## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

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WHEREAS, the Interim Committee on Local Governance of the

2	Missouri House of Representatives (the Committee) submitted a
3	report to the Speaker of the House dated December 31, 2012; and
4	WHEREAS, this report contained a synopsis of the issues
5	presented to the Committee, as well as its recommendations; and
6	WHEREAS, the Committee reported on the governance and
7	taxation issues in the St. Louis Metropolitan Statistical Area
8	(MSA); and
9	WHEREAS, the report details the changes in the laws that
10	make the St. Louis area unique:
11	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the
12	Missouri House Ninety-Seventh General Assembly, First Regular
13	Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby establish the
14	Joint Interim Committee on St. Louis Metropolitan Statistical
15	Area Governance and Taxation (Joint Committee); and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee shall be
17	composed of three majority party members to be appointed by the
18	Speaker of the House of Representatives, two minority party
19	members to be appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
20	Representatives, three majority party members to be appointed by
21	the President Pro Tem of the Senate, and two minority party
22	members to be appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; and
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee shall
24	interview and select an appropriate entity to conduct the

- 1 independent study called for in the report and make
- 2 recommendations to secure the appropriate commitments to fund the
- 3 independent study at no direct cost to the state; and
- 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee shall
- 5 receive the independent study and, upon receipt, review the study
- 6 as well as conduct a comprehensive analysis of the taxation and
- 7 governance issues facing the St. Louis MSA, and make
- 8 recommendations on proposed legislation for the 2014 legislative
- 9 session; and
- 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if this Joint Committee is not
- in receipt of an independent study by September 1, 2013, it shall
- 12 proceed on its own and perform its own investigation and analysis
- of the circumstances so that this Joint Committee shall be able
- 14 to make its recommendation for proposed legislative changes no
- 15 later than December 31, 2013; and
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee is
- authorized to hold public hearings as it deems advisable and may
- solicit, and shall accept, any input or information necessary to
- 19 fulfill its obligations, including but not limited to any agency
- of the state or any political subdivision of the state which the
- 21 committee may find helpful; and
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the staffs of House Research,
- 23 Senate Research, and the Joint Committee on Legislative Research
- 24 shall provide such legal, research, clerical, technical, and bill
- 25 drafting services as the Joint Committee may require in the
- 26 performance of its duties; and
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee, its
- 28 members, and any staff assigned to the Joint Committee shall

1 receive reimbursement for their actual and necessary expenses 2 incurred in attending meetings of the Joint Committee or any subcommittee thereof; and 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee will report 5 its recommendations and findings to the Missouri General Assembly by December 21, 2013; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Committee is 8 authorized to function during the interim between the First 9 Regular Session of the 97th General Assembly through the end of 10 the Second Regular Session of the 97th General Assembly; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Missouri House 11 12 of Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed 13 copies of this resolution for the Speaker of the House of

Representatives and the President Pro Tem of the Senate.

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
