AN ACT

To amend chapters 191 and 197, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to public health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 191 and 197, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 191.761 and 197.168, to read as follows:

2 **191.761. 1. Beginning July 1, 2015, the department of health and senior services**
3 **shall provide a courier service to transport collected, donated umbilical cord blood samples**
4 **to a nonprofit umbilical cord blood bank located in a city not within a county in existence**
5 **as of the effective date of this section. The collection sites shall only be those facilities**
6 **designated and trained by the blood bank in the collection and handling of umbilical cord**
7 **blood specimens.**

8 **2. The department may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this**
9 **section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is**
10 **created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it**
11 **complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable,**
12 **section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers**
13 **vested with the general assembly under chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date,**
14 **or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant**
15 **of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2014, shall be**
invalid and void.

2 **197.168. Each year between October first and March first and in accordance with**
the latest recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the

3 **Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, each hospital licensed under this chapter shall**
4 **offer, prior to discharge and with the approval of the attending physician or other**
5 **practitioner authorized to order vaccinations or as authorized by physician-approved**
6 **hospital policies or protocols for influenza vaccinations pursuant to state hospital**
7 **regulations, immunizations against influenza virus to all inpatients sixty-five years of age**
8 **and older unless contraindicated for such patient and contingent upon the availability of**
9 **the vaccine.**

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
