## AN ACT

To repeal section 275.352, RSMo, relating to beef commodity merchandising program fees.

---

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 275.352, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 [275.352. If a national referendum among beef producers  
3 passes and a federal assessment on beef producers is adopted  
4 pursuant to federal law, no state fees shall be collected under the  
5 provisions of this chapter, in excess of a commensurate amount  
6 credited against the obligation to pay any such federal  
7 assessment. Upon adoption of the federal assessment, beef shall  
be exempt from the refund provision of section 275.360.]
