## AN ACT

To repeal section 57.540, RSMo, relating to attorneys employed by sheriffs in the city of St. Louis.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 57.540, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2           [57.540. The sheriff of the city of St. Louis may employ an  
3 attorney at law to aid and advise him in the discharge of his duties  
4 and to represent him in court, which said attorney shall be known  
5 as "sheriff's attorney", and who shall receive as compensation for  
6 his services as such sheriff's attorney a sum of not less than three  
7 thousand dollars and not more than fifteen thousand dollars per  
8 annum, payable in semimonthly installments out of the same funds  
and revenue as the sheriff of such city is paid.]
