## AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to permits issued by the department of conservation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 252.227, to read as follows:

**252.227. The department of conservation and its permit issuing agents shall not charge a permit fee for the acquisition of a hunting, fishing, or trapping permit for a Missouri resident, except:**

(1) A service fee not to exceed two dollars that is credited to the permit issuing agent;

(2) A customer convenience fee not to exceed two dollars for telephone or electronic media sales that shall be held in trust for the conservation commission and shall be made available for electronic fund transfer to the state treasurer's collection account;

(3) A replacement fee not to exceed two dollars for a lost, destroyed, or mutilated permit that is credited to the permit issuing agent who certifies the permit number and type of permit being replaced and who issues the replacement permit.
