AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto five new sections relating to the designation of highways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto five new sections, to be
2 known as sections 227.218, 227.432, 227.445, 227.446, and 227.528, to read as follows:

2 **227.218. 1. The highways and transportation commission may issue a request for**
3 **proposals to sell or lease naming rights for a particular segment of highway or for a bridge**
4 **to the best qualified bidder. All contracts for the sale or lease of naming rights shall be**
5 **first approved by the highways and transportation commission and then approved by the**
6 **joint committee on transportation. The highways and transportation commission and the**
7 **joint committee on transportation may disapprove a contract for any reason. The proceeds**
8 **of a sale or lease of naming rights shall be deposited into the state road fund.**

8 **2. The purchaser or lessee of a naming right shall pay the cost of erecting,**
9 **maintaining, and removing signage as well as an annual fee as determined by the proposal.**

10 **3. The term of contract for naming rights shall not exceed ten years and may be**
11 **shorter at the discretion of the highways and transportation commission. The purchaser**
12 **or lessee of a naming right shall have an option of early termination.**

13 **4. No naming rights shall be sold or leased for any segment of roadway or bridge**
14 **that has been designated prior to August 28, 2016, as a named memorial highway or bridge**
15 **under this chapter or through the joint committee on transportation approval process**
16 **established under section 227.297.**

17 **5. The department of transportation may promulgate all necessary rules and**
18 **regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that**

19 term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this
20 section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions
21 of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are
22 nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to
23 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
24 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule
25 proposed or adopted after August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void.

26 6. The provisions of this section shall expire on December 31, 2036.

227.432. The portion of Interstate 470 at the interchange with Woods Chapel Road
2 continuing to Lakewood Boulevard in Jackson County shall be designated as the "Judge
3 Vincent E. Baker Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and
4 maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by
5 private donations.

227.445. The portion of State Highway 32 from Stockton Dam Road continuing
2 west to State Highway 39/County Road 1401 within the city limits of Stockton in Cedar
3 County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Matthew S. Chism Memorial Highway".
4 The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating
5 such highway, with costs for such designation to be paid for by private donation.

227.446. The portion of U.S. Highway 50 from County Line Road continuing west
2 to Mockingbird Road in Moniteau County shall be designated as the "Phyllis D. Shelley
3 Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain
4 appropriate signs designating such highway, with costs to be paid for by private donation.

227.528. The portion of State Highway 367 from the southern city limit of
2 Bellefontaine Neighbors north to the intersection of Interstate 270 in St. Louis County shall
3 be designated "Sgt. Peggy Vassallo Way". The department of transportation shall erect
4 and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway with the costs to be paid by
5 private donations.
