## SENATE BILL NO. 202

## AN ACT

To amend chapter 256, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to mining royalties on federal land.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section A. Chapter 256, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 256.725, to read as follows:

  256.725. 1. For fiscal year 2020 and each subsequent fiscal year, moneys disbursed to the office of administration
- from the Office of Natural Resources Revenue within the U.S.
- 7 Department of the Interior from mining royalties on federal land
- 8 <u>located within the state shall be distributed on a proportional</u>
- 9 <u>basis</u> by the office of administration to each county in this
- 10 <u>state where such mining royalties accrued.</u>

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- 2. Each county that receives money under subsection 1 of this section shall allocate such money in the following way:
- (1) Fifty percent to the public schools of the county, of which:
  - (a) Fifty percent shall be divided proportionally between the school districts that lie or are situated partly or wholly within federal land, based on the acres of federal land within

<pre>each district's boundaries; and</pre>
(b) Fifty percent shall be distributed to all school
districts in the county on an average daily attendance basis; and
(2) Fifty percent, to be allocated at the discretion of the
<pre>county commission, to:</pre>
(a) The maintenance of roads and bridges in the county; and
(b) The county's public safety budget, including the
<pre>following areas:</pre>
<pre>a. Sheriff's department;</pre>
b. Jail and care of prisoners;
c. The office of prosecuting attorney;
d. Juvenile officer; and
e. Coroner.
