Senator Announces Missouri Senate

Job Creation 2020 Committee Hearing in Kansas City

Panel Meeting is First in a Series Across the State

JEFFERSON CITY — Sen. Tom Dempsey, R-St. Charles, announced this week that the <u>Senate Job Creation</u> 2020 <u>Committee</u> will conduct a hearing beginning at 9 a.m., Wednesday, September 30, at Rockhurst University's Finucane Center, located in the lower level of the Greenlease Library at the Kansas City campus.

The Senate Job Creation 2020 Committee is responsible for developing a long-term strategy for increasing economic prosperity and opportunities for Missourians. They are tasked with recommending tools to help existing businesses grow and attracting new businesses to Missouri. The committee will meet from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday and hear from industry leaders in the fields of engineering, energy and small business. Representatives from Kansas will also speak about successful programs enacted in that state to spur economic development. Plus the committee will learn about the Proteon Therapeutics story as well as the Kansas City Science Initiative.
