2 by striking all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof 3 the following: "present in the United States or any person who gained illegal entry into the United States;"; and 4 Further amend said bill, page 120, section 169.560, 5 line 107 by inserting after all of said line the following: 6 7 "169.660. 1. On and after the first day of July next 8 following the operative date, any member who is sixty or 9 more years of age and who has at least five years of creditable service, or who has attained age fifty-five and 10 has at least twenty-five years of creditable service, or who 11 12 has at least thirty years of creditable service regardless of age may retire and receive the full retirement benefits 13 based on the member's creditable service. A member whose 14 15 creditable service at retirement is less than five years 16 shall not be entitled to a retirement allowance but shall be entitled to receive the member's contributions. 17 2. Any person retired and currently receiving a 18 retirement allowance pursuant to sections 169.600 to 19 169.715[, other than for disability,] may be employed on 20 either a part-time or temporary-substitute basis by a 21 district included in the retirement system not to exceed a 22 23 total of five hundred fifty hours in any one school year, 24 without a discontinuance of the person's retirement allowance. Such a person shall not contribute to the 25 26 retirement system, or to the public school retirement system

- established by sections 169.010 to 169.141, because of
- 28 earnings during such period of employment. If such a person
- 29 is employed in any capacity by such a district on a regular,
- 30 full-time basis, or the person's part-time or temporary-
- 31 substitute service in any capacity exceeds five hundred
- 32 fifty hours in any one school year, the person shall not be
- 33 eligible to receive the person's retirement allowance for
- 34 any month during which the person is so employed or the
- 35 retirement system shall recover the amount the person earned
- 36 in excess of the limitations, whichever is less.
- 3. The system shall pay a monthly retirement allowance
- 38 for the month in which a retired member or beneficiary
- 39 receiving a retirement allowance dies."; and
