AN ACT

To repeal section 301.058, RSMo 2000, relating to motor vehicles, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.058, RSMo 2000, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 301.058, to read as follows:

301.058. 1. The annual registration fee for property-carrying local commercial motor vehicles, other than a land improvement contractors' commercial motor vehicles, based on gross weight is:

6,000 pounds and under \$ 15	5.50
6,001 pounds to 12,000 pounds	.00
12,001 pounds to 18,000 pounds	
18,001 pounds to 24,000 pounds	.50
24,001 pounds to 26,000 pounds	.50
26,001 pounds to 30,000 pounds	.50
30,001 pounds to 36,000 pounds	.50
36,001 pounds to 42,000 pounds	.50
42,001 pounds to 48,000 pounds	.50
48,001 pounds to 54,000 pounds	.50
54,001 pounds to 60,010 pounds	.50
60,011 pounds to 66,000 pounds	.50
66,001 pounds to 72,000 pounds	5.50

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

2. Any person found to have improperly registered a motor vehicle in excess of fifty-four thousand pounds when he was not entitled to shall be required to purchase the proper license plates and, in addition to all other penalties provided by law, shall be subject to the annual registration fee for the full calendar year for the vehicle's gross weight as prescribed in section 301.057.
