Senator John Loudon's Workers' Comp Bill Voted Out of House Committee

JEFFERSON CITY— A measure sponsored by State Sen. John Loudon, R-Ballwin, revising Missouri's workers' compensation laws to lower insurance premiums for businesses today was voted out of the House Workforce Development & Workplace Safety Committee.

Senate Bill 1 is designed to ensure that Missouri's workers' compensation system only covers legitimate work-related injury claims.

"The bill getting passed through the House committee is a significant step forward in the legislative process," Loudon said. "It's encouraging to see the bill moving along at such a quick pace because it means we are that much closer to making Missouri a more business-friendly state."

The bill is expected to go to the House floor for debate sometime next week where it is expected to pass.

"This legislation is in line with the governor's pro-business approach to spur economic development in our state," Loudon said.
