Sworn into the Missouri Senate

JEFFERSON CITY – Timothy P. Green was sworn into the Missouri Senate on January 5, 2004 for the 13th District. He represents the citizens of the City of Florissant, Black Jack, Jennings, Bellefontaine Neighbors, Riverview, Moline Acres and surrounding un-incorporated North St. Louis County. “I am honored to represent the people of North St. Louis County and I will work hard for the people of the 13th District,” Senator Green said.

In addition to his legislative duties, Senator Green works as a construction electrician for Briner Electrical Co. and he serves as the president of the Missouri State Building & Construction Trades Council (AFL-CIO). “I want to make it easier for hard working families to balance competing demands at home and at work- to be able to spend more time with their families,” he said.

A graduate of St. Aloysius Grade School and 1981 graduate of Rosary High School, Senator Green received a degree in business administration from the University of Missouri-St. Louis and graduated from Electrical Industry Training Center IBEW-NECA in 1987. He served in the Missouri House of Representatives from 1989-2002, where during his last two years, he served as Budget Chairman.
