Sen. Frank Barnitz Announces \$500,000 Grant for the City of Doolittle

JEFFERSON CITY – State Senator Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, is proud to announce that Doolittle will receive a \$500,000 community grant. The Community Development Block Grant will be used to expand the city’s wastewater collection system.
