# Sen. Frank Barnitz Announces \$179,400 in Tax Credits for Camp David of Ozarks

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, is proud to announce that \$179,400 in tax credits have been made available to Shepherd Heart Ministries' Camp David of the Ozarks. The funds will be used to construct a multipurpose building at the camp, which is located 10 miles south of Rolla.

“These funds will provide needed infrastructure for the benefit of the children served by Camp David of the Ozarks,” Barnitz said. “The camp offers invaluable assistance to at-risk youths, and I know this funding will help further the camp’s philanthropic commitment.”

Shepherd’s Heart Ministries will build a 5,000-square-foot multipurpose facility at Camp David of the Ozarks, which provides summer-camp experiences for the children of prisoners and other at-risk youth. The new building will include a kitchen, dining room and bathrooms. Staff housing will be located above the kitchen, and the dining room will feature a stage, allowing the facility to be used for meetings and meals. The building will be available to the surrounding communities during the off-season for club, church and civic meetings.

Tax credits were provided by the Missouri Department of Economic Development’s Neighborhood Assistance Program.
