Sen. Bill Stouffer Announces Tax Credits for Glasgow Senior Center

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that the Glasgow Senior Center has been awarded tax credits from the State of Missouri in the amount of \$124,028. The money will be used to renovate and modernize the historic facility, circa 1870, which will allow the center to accommodate more patrons for a greater range of services in a more spacious, accessible and appropriately-designed facility. The Neighborhood Assistance Program tax credits will ensure that quality services are available locally for future generations of senior citizens.

"As a representative of their service area, I have become acquainted with the essential services the Glasgow Senior Center provides," Stouffer said. "I applaud the efforts to the Glasgow Senior Center board of directors to work together to identify the future needs of Glasgow area seniors. This tax credit award will allow the Glasgow Senior Center to successfully meet its long-term goals."

Missouri's Department of Economic Development administers the Neighborhood Assistance Program to provide assistance to community-based organizations that enable them to implement community or neighborhood projects in the areas of community service, education, crime prevention, job training and physical revitalization.

"This tax credit may allow the senior center to expand current services, like monthly blood pressure screenings, to cook more meals and begin to offer breakfast," Stouffer said.
