Sen. Bill Stouffer Announces \$500,000 Community Grant for Odessa

JEFFERSON CITY – State Senator Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, is proud to announce that the city of Odessa will receive a \$500,000 community grant. The Community Development Block Grant will be used to improve the city’s wastewater collection system.
