## Senator Bill Stouffer Announces Grants Awarded to Two Communities in 21<sup>st</sup> District

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that two communities in the 21<sup>st</sup> Senate District have received Community Development Block Grants from the Department of Economic Development. The funds will be used for street and drainage projects in Camden and Otterville.

"Camden and Otterville will be able to make needed improvements to their infrastructure," Stouffer said. "These funds will be used to better the lives of all residents."

The funding is distributed as follows:

- Camden was awarded \$400,000 for street improvements.
- Otterville received \$359,317 for street and drainage improvements.

Grant amounts are based on correspondence between grant staff and community officials. The Department of Economic Development relies on this correspondence to discern which grant requests are most deserving.

"I applaud the efforts made by community leaders to obtain this funding," Stouffer said. "The work they have done to foster development is outstanding."
