## **Sen. Jason Crowell Visits District Classrooms**

JEFFERSON CITY— During these next few months, Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, will be visiting 21 area schools to promote lifetime learning and bring civics to life for students in the 27<sup>th</sup> Senate District.

“I am so excited to take the time to meet my young constituents and learn what it is like to be a fourth-, fifth- and sixth-grader in Missouri today,” Sen. Crowell said. “I’m not going to lecture to them. I’m going to talk with them—about their lives, about school, about what I do at the Capitol.”

Each class will be different, Sen. Crowell said, so he does not plan on following a strict agenda while he is in the classrooms. But he does want to encourage the children to read as much as they can and never turn down an opportunity to learn. To show the students the value of a fair debate, they will be given a discussion topic they can relate to, such as what is considered a fair amount of homework, and share with Sen. Crowell their views on the issue.

“The students will lead the discussion so I can get their perspectives on what they are thinking while giving them a hands-on way to understand what I do on the Senate floor,” Crowell said. “Enhancing their education by personally visiting with them is important to me because they are my bosses—I work for them.”

Sen. Crowell will kick off the school visits this Thursday, Oct. 6, at A.J. Martin Elementary when he meets with more than 80 fifth-graders.
