Sen. Jason Crowell To Throw Pizza Party for 5th-Grade Class in East Prairie

JEFFERSON CITY—Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, announced today that he will reward 25 East Prairie fifth-graders with pizza and a surprise appearance Friday because they successfully answered a research question during the senator's last visit.

Sen. Crowell met with Melissa Jackson's fifth-grade class at A.J. Martin Elementary last week to talk with the students about lifetime learning and the legislative process. One student wanted to know how much money Sen. Crowell earned as a lawmaker, so the senator challenged the class to research the answer using resources in their library.

"Before I was even out of the parking lot, the class called my Capitol office with the answer," Crowell said. "I was so impressed with their quick response and enthusiasm that I just couldn't let their efforts go unrewarded."

To show his appreciation, Sen. Crowell will provide pizza from Kathy's Hometown Deli for the 25 students. He will also surprise them with a return visit during which he will congratulate them on their team work to come up with the right answer.

"I'm excited to see the kids again and show them that their efforts paid off," Crowell said. "I'm sure they'll be just as eager to eat pizza as they are to learn."
