Senator Jason Crowell Announces Grant Award for Perryville Soccer Park

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, today announced that the city of Perryville was awarded a grant from the Department of Natural Resources for the amount of \$150,000.

The money will go toward enhancing Perryville’s 31-acre soccer park, including new concession stands and pavilions, an irrigation system for the fields, and features for the walking trail to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility requirements.

“Winning this grant was a result of collective efforts from community members who have been dedicated to improving the soccer park since its founding,” Crowell said. “I am excited for the Perryville community and pleased that their hard work paid off.”

Perryville is one of the 22 Missouri communities to receive grant money from the National Park Service as part of the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF), which cities, county and state governments can apply for to fund outdoor recreation projects.
