# Senator Jason Crowell Announces Grant Award for Fredericktown

---

JEFFERSON CITY—State Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, today announced that the city of Fredericktown has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for the amount of \$341,500.

The money will go toward rerouting Highway 72 and building an access road to the city's industrial park.

“Community members were awarded for their collective efforts to continue moving Fredericktown forward,” Crowell said. “This money will fund projects that, added to the recent construction of a Wal-mart Supercenter and expansion of the highway, will help the city revitalize its infrastructure.”

The CDBG, which is allocated by the Missouri Department of Economic Development, is set up to assist small Missouri communities in improving local facilities, addressing critical health and safety concerns and developing a greater capacity for growth.

“Increasing access to Fredericktown's business district will be beneficial in the near future, as well as for many years down the road,” Crowell said. “I'm glad that the block-grant staff saw what Fredericktown needed and did what they could to fulfill that need.”
