## **Sen. Crowell Encourages Eligible Veterans to Apply for War-Medallion Programs**

JEFFERSON CITY—State Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, is working with Adjutant General King Sidwell to encourage eligible Missouri veterans and their spouses to apply for the Missouri World War II and Korean War Medallion programs. Legislation was passed this year to remove the application deadlines and open up eligibility requirements.

These programs award a medal, medallion and certificate to Missouri veterans who served during World War II or the Korean War; Missouri residents who entered or were discharged from military service during these wars are also qualified to apply.

“It is important that these courageous men and women are rightfully recognized for their honorable service to the United States and Missouri,” Crowell said. “These veterans deserve to have this award symbolizing their bravery and Missouri’s appreciation.”
