EMERGENCY 911

AMBULANCE, FIRE OR POLICE

For your convenience, Kansas City and Jackson County have consolidated their respective emergency numbers and established a 911 emergency number. At any time of the day or night, you may contact needed emergency services simply by dialing 911 and giving the following information:

1. Nature of the emergency. 2. Exact location - street address. 3. Phone Number from which you are calling.

FOR CITY SERVICES -- DIAL 311

By mid-July, Kansas City residents should be able to call **311** for basic city services in the same way they call 911 for emergencies.

The City Council's Finance Committee endorsed a method to finance the system, which carries a price tag of about \$5.3 million, over the next eight years.

The city budget next year will include about \$750,000 to cover the annual debt service on the system.

City officials say the new **311** call center should be up and running by mid-July, if not sooner. It will give residents better access to city services

and will be easier to remember than the Action Center number, 816-513-1313. It also will take the place of hot lines that the city has set up to report such things as potholes and slick spots after snowstorms.

Callers to **311** will be able to speak to a person between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday, and at least from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays. On Sundays, callers will be able to leave a message, and may be able to speak to a person if the call volume warrants it.

Officials also hope it will reduce the non-emergency calls that currently go to 911.

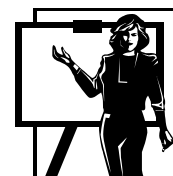

If you are 65 years of age or on disability for two years, you are also eligible for Medicare to help pay for health care. The hospital part of Medicare (Part A), which pays for a large portion of any hospitalization you may require, is FREE. The medical part (doctor's service, Part B) will cost you \$54.00 per month under current law.

If you begin receiving Social Security money benefits before age 65 (anytime from age 62 to 65), you will not become eligible for Medicare until you reach 65. If, on the other hand, you do not retire at age 65 and do not start collecting money benefits then, you will nevertheless be eligible for Medicare at that time--at age 65.

You may check on Medicare benefits with the Social Security Administration.

Medicaid Information 800-392-2161

Medicaid is a health assistance program administered by the state according to certain federal guidelines. Benefits are available to people who are temporarily or permanently disabled, as well as low-income families and many others.

Medicaid pays for visits to the doctor; immunization against diseases such as measles, tetanus and polio; ambulance services in case of emergency; in-patient hospital care; yearly eye examinations; children's glasses; laboratory and X-ray services; home health care services; family planning services; certain dental work and certain prescriptions.
