



Senator Scott T. Rupp Sworn in as Senator from 2nd District

JEFFERSON CITY — Senator Scott T. Rupp, R-Wentzville, was sworn in today as the state senator from Missouri's 2nd Senate District. Rupp was voted into the Senate in an April special election. The 2nd Senate District seat was vacated in November 2005.

"This moment would not have been possible without the efforts of the friends, family and other supporters who helped get me here," Rupp said. "It is an honor to represent the people of the 2nd Senate District."

Rupp was sworn in just after 10 a.m. on the chamber floor. Fellow senators gathered to congratulate Rupp upon swearing in. Rupp will represent Lincoln County and part of St. Charles County in the Missouri Senate.

"The warm welcome from my Senate colleagues was very gracious, though I am eager to get to work" Rupp said. "I know there is not a lot of time left in session, but I want to do as much as I can with the time I have."

Rupp had served in the Missouri House since 2002. In addition to his legislative duties, Rep. Rupp owns Educational Funding & Financial Aid Specialists, a college prep company; Rupp & Associates, an investment firm; and Educational Financing Company, a mortgage brokerage firm specializing in loans for parents of college-bound students.
