Working to Protect our Children from Internet Abuse

In my continued effort to offer greater protections to Missouri children, this week I introduced a proposal to fund task forces that will capture online sexual predators in Missouri. As these dangerous criminals continue to find new ways to try to exploit and abuse our children, we must remain steadfast in working to defeat their efforts. Although technology has given predators new means for abuse, we can also use those same innovations to capture these vile individuals.

My proposal calls for the creation of a program to distribute grants to Internet law-enforcement task forces and other law-enforcement agencies within the Missouri Department of Public Safety. The grants will be used to train and keep on staff specialized detectives and computer forensic personnel whose focus will be to investigate Internet sex crimes against children, including enticement of a child and possession or promotion of child pornography.

An eight-member panel will oversee the establishment and funding of the program, which must first be approved by the House and Senate appropriations committees. My staff and I are working to procure \$3 to 5 million for the new program. State Rep. Bob Dixon, R-Springfield, is introducing similar legislation in the House.

An estimated 20 percent of children between the age of 10 and 17 have received an unwanted online sexual solicitation. This is a troubling statistic, but we cannot sit back and allow this to happen. We have to have the determination to take the fight to these sick individuals. The safety of our children is at stake.
