Senator Frank Barnitz Makes Two Visits to Dixon

JEFFERSON CITY – State Senator Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, as part of his promise to keep in touch with Missourians in the 16th Senate District, made two recent visits to northern Pulaski County and the city of Dixon. During his first trip, the Senator stopped at the Dixon Senior Center, greeting those in attendance at the center’s Senior Volunteer Appreciation Day.

Senator Barnitz was joined by his in-district legislative assistant, former State Representative Bill Ransdall, who is very much familiar with northern Pulaski County after serving four consecutive, two-year terms in the Missouri House of Representatives. Representative Ransdall was honored at the senior center for his part in helping the center procure \$307,000 in tax credits – funds that helped in the building of the facility. One woman at the event said that Senator Barnitz was the first senator to ever visit the senior center. It was, in fact, Senator Barnitz’s second visit.

During his second visit to Dixon, just last week, Senator Barnitz stopped and saw local bankers and had lunch at a local restaurant, where the Senator heard needs and concerns from local citizens about everything from economic development, education, and law enforcement. Before leaving town, Senator Barnitz visited other businesses, including a feed store, where the agriculture economy was the topic.

“I really enjoyed my two visits with the residents of Dixon, and I look forward to coming back in the near future,” said Senator Barnitz, who today started his first full term as the senator from the 16th District of Missouri. “I encourage the people of Dixon and northern Pulaski County to call, write, or stop by my office in Jefferson City and share their comments with me.” The Senator’s office is in Room 425 of the State Capitol.
