Sen. Frank A. Barnitz is Appointed to Boundary Commission

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Frank A. Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, today was appointed to a state commission charged with negotiating state boundaries with representatives from neighboring states.

Barnitz was appointed to the Missouri Boundary Commission. Members of the body represent the state of Missouri and may enter into negotiations with representatives from bordering states concerning the official boundaries between Missouri and its neighbors. Borders marked by rivers or other waterways can adjust due to environmental changes, and commissioners are responsible for negotiating what these border changes mean for states.

“I am honored to serve as a representative of Missouri’s borders,” Barnitz said. “The changing nature of physical borders is actually quite interesting, and I am looking forward to getting to work.”
