Sen. Frank Barnitz Welcomes to the Capitol Jean Finn, Outstanding Older Worker Semi-Finalist

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, welcomed last week to the Missouri State Capitol Jean Finn of Rolla. Ms. Finn was named a semi-finalist in the 16th Annual Missouri Outstanding Older Worker program, sponsored by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. Sen. Barnitz presented a Senate resolution to Ms. Finn for her accomplishment.

Ms. Finn has been employed at Heritage Park Skilled Care in Rolla since 1990. She is currently the Business Office Manager and also participates in the facility's adopt-a-resident program, "Frieda's Friends." Ms. Finn's supervisor, Teresa K. Williams, nominated her for the award.

"Ms. Finn is certainly an invaluable resource to the residents and staff at Heritage Park Skilled Care, and it is very appropriate for her to be honored by the Missouri Outstanding Older Worker Program," said Sen. Barnitz. "It was my pleasure to present to her a Senate resolution."
