Senator Bill Stouffer Announces \$22,650 Grant Awarded to City of Armstrong

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that a \$22,650 grant has been awarded to the City of Armstrong to improve drinking water conditions for residents. Grant money will be used to connect Armstrong to the Clarence Cannon Wholesale Water Commission for access to drinking water.

“These needed funds are important to improving the lives of Armstrong residents,” Stouffer said. “All citizens of our state deserve access to safe, clean drinking water.”

Funds were made available by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Water Protection Program, which works to improve water quality throughout the state.
