Senator Bill Stouffer Announces Grants for Macon and Arrow Rock

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that the city of Macon has been awarded a \$156,660 grant from the Missouri Department of Economic Development and Arrow Rock has received an \$8,104 matching grant from the state natural resources department.

"The 21st District will gain needed resources thanks to this program funding," Stouffer said. "The educational opportunities in Macon and historical legacy of Arrow Rock will benefit from these important grants."

Macon's \$156,600 Community Development Block Grant will be used for the Macon Area Vocational Technical School. The Arrow Rock grant, along with \$5,403 in local funds, will be used to conduct a 25-acre archeological survey of privately owned land within its National Historic Landmark boundaries. The survey will determine the historical significance of privately owned land, which is under increasing threats from new developments. The Arrow Rock grant requires final approval by the U.S. Department of the Interior.

Macon received the funding through the federal Community Development Block Grant program. Arrow Rock's grant was made on behalf of the federal Historic Preservation Fund.
