## **Sen. Bill Stouffer Announces Tax Credits for Marshall Museum**

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, is proud to announce that \$350,000 in tax credits have been made available to go toward the Marshall Civic Center and Nicholas-Beazley Aviation Museum.

The multi-use facility will host civic and business functions and include a building devoted to the history of the airplane manufacturer, Nicholas-Beazley Airplane Company, and the Marshall Flying School, which had been the world's largest civilian flight school.

“Marshall and surrounding areas will finally have a spacious and convenient place at which to hold community events, such as seminars and theater programs,” Stouffer said. “This is good news for Saline County, because the civic center will strengthen the community and the museum will attract visitors and aviation enthusiasts.”

Tax credits were provided by the Missouri Department of Economic Development's Neighborhood Assistance Program.
