Bridges and Highways for Southeast Missouri

Earlier this week, Missouri Department of Transportation Director Pete Rahn delivered the annual State of Transportation address. Leading the department under the motto that, "Dreams minus action equals squat," MoDOT is "making progress we can feel."

He commended MoDOT's efforts over the past year to improve Missouri's transportation system and said that Missourians can further expect advancements in 2006. Under the Smooth Roads Initiative, MoDOT is repaying more than 2,000 miles of roads, widening and adding lanes, putting rumble strips on shoulders and updating guardrails. These improvements go hand in hand with MoDOT's number one priority of ensuring motorists' safety.

Below is a list of road construction projects that MoDOT will undertake in the 27th Senatorial District in 2006.



2006 Projects Planned by MoDOT in the 27th Senatorial District

Perry, Cape Girardeau & Scott Counties

I-55

Diamond grind pavement and resurface shoulders on both northbound and southbound lanes from Jefferson County to Arkansas state line.

Cape Girardeau County

I-55

Construct East Main Street/ LaSalle Avenue/ I-55 interchange 2.4 miles north of Route 34 &61.

Route 34

Scott County(continued)

Route K(Main Street)

Resurface pavement and shoulders from west of I-55 to Route N in Scott City.

Route 62

Resurface from Route 61/114 intersection to I-55 interchange in Sikeston.

Outer Road

Outer road improvements and new bridge over Ramsey Creek to connect Scott City to Route AB

Scott & Mississippi Counties

Widen and resurface existing route, signals, curb, gutter and storm sewer from 2.2 miles to 1 mile west of Route 25 in Jackson

Route 61

Diamond grind pavement and resurface shoulders from Route 34/25 intersection at Jackson to South Kingshighway exit ramp with I-55 in Cape.

Route K(William Street)

Diamond grind pavement and resurface shoulders from Route 25 in Gordonville to Route 61 in Cape.

Route D

Signalization of Route D and Farmington Road intersection in Jackson.

Scott County

I-57

Replace both the northbound and southbound I-57 bridges over North Cut Ditch, located half-mile east of I-55.

I-57

Diamond grind pavement and resurface shoulders on both northbound and southbound lanes from I-55 to Illinois state line.

Mississippi County

Route 80

Replace bridge half-mile west of Route 77.

Bollinger County

Route 72

Partial relocation on new alignment and intersection improvements at Route 72/51(Patton Junction).

Madison County

Route 72

Widen and resurface with paved shoulders from Route OO to 0.9 mile west of Castor River.

Relocation and new bridge over Castor River
