Missouri Senate Recognizes District Trucking Company for Safety Record

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, today announced that the Missouri Senate adopted a resolution honoring Rollet Brothers Logistics, Inc. of Perryville for winning a Fleet Safety Award.

The trucking company, which is owned by Elvis and Shirley Rollet, was selected by the Missouri Motor Carriers Association for this award because the company's fleet logged nearly 2 million miles in the past year and experienced no accidents by company vehicles.

"Trucking companies are such crucial elements in transporting goods across the country," Crowell said. "Getting to the destinations safely is good for the economy and it also saves lives, so I congratulate the members of the Rollet Brothers Logistic fleet for having successfully practiced caution and responsibility on the roads."
