## **Sen. Crowell Welcomes Franklin Elementary 4<sup>th</sup>-Graders to the Capitol**

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, this week welcomed to the Capitol 42 fourth-graders from Franklin Elementary School. The students visited both the Senate and House chambers, and attended a theatrical performance called *Archives Alive!*

“I’m glad the students got the opportunity to come to Jefferson City and visit the Capitol,” Crowell said. “For most of the students, this is their first visit to the capitol and their first time experiencing how state government operates.
