Sen. Jason Crowell Recognizes Cape Girardeau, Perry and Bollinger Counties' Children's Division

JEFFERSON CITY— Sen. Jason Crowell, R-Cape Girardeau, today announced that the Missouri Senate adopted a resolution recognizing the 32nd Circuit Cape Girardeau, Perry and Bollinger counties Children's Division for receiving accreditation after completing a rigorous inspection process.

The accreditation came after the 32nd Circuit Children's Division underwent site visits this past spring in line with legislation passed in 2004 calling for the Children's Division receiving accreditation statewide by the end of the fiscal year 2009. Accreditation enables the division to provide higher quality services, boost worker morale, enhance consumer confidence, increase professionalism and standardize caseloads.

"Reaching this milestone would not have been possible if it weren't for the dedication and hard work of the children's division staff," Crowell said. "I congratulate them for being recognized as a sound administrative agency so the division can continue to provide quality child-welfare services to the people of the great state of Missouri."
