Sen. Scott Re-Elected to Leadership Position

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Delbert Scott, R-Lowry City, was unanimously re-elected by his peers to serve as Caucus Secretary of the Missouri Senate Majority Caucus.

"Delbert may not be the dean of the Missouri Senate in years served," Senate President Pro Tem Michael Gibbons, R-Kirkwood, said. "But he is dean of the Senate in measure of respect. His wise advice has helped us through difficult issues many times."

Scott was re-elected to his position in party caucuses held by senators in the state Capitol following last Tuesday's General Election.

"Being chosen by my colleagues for this position is an honor as the legislative session is less than two months away," Scott said. "This session promises to be an eventful one with several key issues at the forefront of my party's agenda."
