Sen. Chris Koster Re-Elected to Leadership Position

JEFFERSON CITY— For the second year in a row, Sen. Chris Koster, R-Harrisonville, was unanimously elected by his peers to serve as chairman of the Missouri Senate Majority Caucus.

“Once again, being chosen for this position is an honor as the legislative session is less than two months away,” Koster said. “This session promises to be an eventful one with several key issues at the forefront of my party’s agenda, and as a caucus leader, I will do what I can to help the body improve state government in the name of Missouri citizens.”

As majority caucus chairman, Koster will lead majority caucus meetings and play an instrumental role in the coordination of legislative strategies to advance the agendas of the 21 Senate members in his political party.

Senate President Pro Tem Michael R. Gibbons said Koster has improved coordination within the caucus.

“He brings a good perspective and strong organizations skills,” Gibbons said. “Chris has been a valuable leader as we work to improve the opportunities to the people of Missouri.”

Koster was elected to his position today in party caucuses held by senators in the state Capitol following Tuesday’s General Election. The First Regular Session of the 94th Missouri General Assembly will convene in Jefferson City on Jan. 3.
