AN ACT

To repeal section 137.390, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to determination of tax rates for county commissions, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 137.390, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 137.390, to read as follows:

137.390. After the assessor's book shall be corrected and adjusted 2 according to law, but not later than [August tenth] **September twentieth** of 3 each year, the county commission shall ascertain the sum necessary to be raised 4 for county purposes, and fix the rate of taxes on the several subjects of taxation 5 so as to raise the required sum, and the same shall be entered in proper columns 6 in the tax book.

Section B. Because of the need to ensure the accurate determination of tax 2 rates by county commissions, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the 3 immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is 4 hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, 5 and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and 6 approval.

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EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
