AN ACT

To repeal section 79.365, RSMo, relating to boards of fourth class cities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 79.365, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 [79.365. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
3 contrary, in all cities of the fourth class, the board of alderpersons
4 shall have the authority to fix the compensation, not to exceed two
5 hundred dollars per month, of members of the planning and zoning
6 commission, the board of adjustment, the park board and the board
 of police commissioners of the city by ordinance.]

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
