## AN ACT

To amend chapter 165, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to authorization of additional fund transfers for school districts meeting certain qualifications, with a termination date and an emergency clause.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 165, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new  
2 section, to be known as section 165.018, to read as follows:

**165.018. 1. Any school district shall be permitted to make a one-  
2 time additional transfer from the incidental fund to the capital projects  
3 fund in an amount not to exceed forty percent of that district's June 30,  
4 2006, incidental fund if such school district meets one of the following  
5 qualifications:**

6       **(1) Has an average daily attendance between nine hundred forty  
7 and one thousand forty during the 2004-2005 school year, located at  
8 least partially in a county of the third classification with a township  
9 form of government and with more than twenty-nine thousand seven  
10 hundred but fewer than twenty-nine thousand eight hundred  
11 inhabitants and which entirely encompasses a city of the fourth  
12 classification with more than one thousand one hundred but fewer than  
13 one thousand two hundred inhabitants; or**

14       **(2) Has an average daily attendance between six hundred and six  
15 hundred thirty during the 2004-2005 school year, located at least**

16 partially in any county of the second classification with more than fifty-  
17 five thousand six hundred but fewer than fifty-five thousand seven  
18 hundred inhabitants; or

19 (3) Has an average daily attendance between four hundred sixty  
20 and four hundred ninety during the 2004-2005 school year, located at  
21 least partially in any county of the third classification without a  
22 township form of government and with more than twenty-three  
23 thousand two hundred fifty but fewer than twenty-three thousand three  
24 hundred fifty inhabitants.

25 2. The provisions of this section shall terminate on July 1, 2007.

Section B. Because of the need to allow certain school districts to  
2 efficiently utilize their funds, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the  
3 immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is  
4 hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution,  
5 and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and  
6 approval.
