Senator Green Announces Four In-District Town Hall Meetings

JEFFERSON CITY, MO – Sen. Timothy Green, D-Spanish Lake, is announcing the first in a series of four “Service Bazaars” – Town Hall meetings, each concentrating on state aid and services provided to his constituents – scheduled throughout the 13th district.

“These Town Hall meetings are opportunities for me to listen to my constituents and for the public to learn about the various state services provided by their tax dollars,” said Sen. Green.

The first, scheduled for Thursday, February 8th, will be held at the Bellefontaine City Hall, with the focus on mental health issues and social services.

“This is about a dialogue of ideas and information,” said the Sen. Green.

Representatives from the Missouri Attorney General’s Consumer Protection Division, the Missouri Department of Mental Health (for an update on the Bellefontaine HAB Center), the Missouri Department of Social Services, Missouri Department of Revenue and Missouri Public Service Commission, which regulates utilities, plan to attend.

“Constituents are encouraged to attend and voice their concerns and ideas,” said Sen. Green. “These town hall meetings will encourage discussion among a local audience, community leaders, and elected officials.”

Sen. Green will be joined by Missouri State Representative Gina Walsh (D-69) and Missouri Public Service Commissioner Steve Gaw.
