

Florissant – Blackjack Area Town Hall Meeting

JEFFERSON CITY, MO – Sen. Timothy Green, D-Spanish Lake, will hold the third in a series of five Town Hall meetings throughout the 13th district on Thursday, March 15. The meeting will concentrate on state aid and services provided to his constituents.

"Rarely do the people have direct access to a wide vary of state agencies in one evening," said Sen. Green. "These meetings are opportunities for me to listen to my constituents and for the public to learn about the various state services provided by their tax dollars."

Representatives from the Missouri Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division, the Missouri Department of Social Services, Missouri Department of Revenue, and the Missouri Public Service Commission, which regulates utilities, plan to attend the March 15th meeting.

The third town hall meeting will be held on Thursday, March 15th at the James J. Eagan Center Theater, One James J. Egan Dr. Sen. Green will be joined by Missouri State Representative Bruce Darrough, Blackjack Mayor Norman McCourt and Florissant Mayor Robert Lowery.
