Sen. Frank Barnitz Congratulates Hermann on Downtown Revitalization Grant

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, today announced the City of Hermann has been approved for a \$399,600 grant. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) will be used for downtown revitalization projects.

Grants are issued by the Missouri Department of Economic Development. Block grant staffers at the Community Development division rely on communication with community leaders to determine which areas are most deserving of development grants.
