Sen. Frank Barnitz Greets Visitors from Salem Elementary School

JEFFERSON CITY – Sen. Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, recently welcomed to the state Capitol a large gathering of students, teachers and chaperones from Salem Elementary School. The visitors enjoyed tours of the state Capitol and Governor's Mansion on Thursday, March 1.

"It was a pleasure meeting with the outstanding students, teachers and chaperones of Salem Elementary," Barnitz said. "I am encouraged that so many of our young people are interested in public policy and the legislative process."

The Capitol visitors included 83 students, four teachers and 10 chaperones. Guests were treated to tours of the state Capitol at 10:20 and 10:40 a.m. and a half-hour tour of the Governor's Mansion beginning at 11:30 a.m.

"The art, architecture and history of Jefferson City are truly remarkable, and the Salem visitors were clearly interested in everything our state capital has to offer," Barnitz said. "But these features are nothing like watching a handful of adults try to corral 83 elementary school students. That truly is a sight to see."
