# **Senator Bill Stouffer Announces \$50,000 Grant for Salisbury Community Development**

JEFFERSON CITY – State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, today announced that the city of Salisbury has been awarded a \$50,000 grant by the Missouri Department of Economic Development. The funding will be used for the demolition of blighted downtown buildings.

“By demolishing these blighted buildings, we make room for new businesses to move in and help the economic growth in this state,” Stouffer said. “There are areas all over Missouri that hold the potential for economic development and I’m pleased that Salisbury is now one of them.”

The Community Development Block Grant Program offers grants to Missouri communities to improve local facilities, address critical health and safety concerns, and develop a greater capacity for growth.

Grants are issued by the Missouri Department of Economic Development. Block grant staffers at the Community Development division rely on communication with community leaders to determine which areas are most deserving of development grants.
