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Dexter Resident Named Senate Physician of the Day

JEFFERSON CITY — Sen. Rob Mayer, R-Dexter, was pleased to have a Dexter resident recently serve as Physician of the Day for the Missouri Legislature. Dr. Alan Chen was introduced to members of the Senate as Physician of the Day on Wednesday, Jan. 3, the first day of session. Dr. Chen was joined at the Capitol by his wife, June.

“Being named the Physician of the Day is a great honor,” Mayer said. “I congratulate Dr. Chen for receiving such a noteworthy achievement, and I thank him for his service to the people of Dexter.”

Dr. Chen is a family practice physician in Dexter and a member of the Dexter School District Board of Education. He previously served as Physician of the Day in 2001.

A Physician of the Day is introduced each day in the Capitol, and his or her name becomes a permanent part of the official legislative record. The physician remains on call throughout the day to provide medical attention to state representatives, senators and Capitol staff. The program is sponsored by the Missouri State Medical Association.
